Training the 21st Century Marine Professional: A new vision for marine graduate education and training programmes in Europe EMB Future Science Brief 2, April 2018



The EMB work on Marine Graduate Training was conducted by a working group of 11 members from 2014 to 2018. The working group was chaired by Magda Vincx (Ghent University, Belgium), and the publication was completed with support from consultant Conor O'Carroll, Ireland.

The Future Science Brief was launched at a dedicated event at the European Parliament on "Young Talent and the Blue Economy" on 25 September 2018. Over 50 participants attended the event and the launch was covered on the EMB website and Twitter account. This was a key communication and dissemination highlight for the document, with a diverse panel of speakers, including early career researchers, providing their perspectives and discussing the way forward.

The main messages of the document were also highlighted to over 60 registered participants, including those from industry, at a workshop on "The Future of Observations from Seabed to Space: Training to Support Marine Science". The workshop was held online as part of Sea Tech Week 2020, and featured a diversity of speakers from academia and industry.

Other communication highlights for the Future Science Brief included it being shared with the H2020 funded project MATES partners, as this project also focuses on marine training, and a presentation of the findings to the EuroMarine working group on "Strategic Agenda to support Blue Growth sectors through the Enhancement of Human resources: a focus on fisheries, aquaculture, and seafood processing (EHUSEA)".

This publication raised further awareness of this very relevant topic for the wider scope of marine and maritime sectors which EMB and it's members cover.
